

## ***Guidelines to apply for the B.Ed. Course – December 2020***

*Minimum Requirements for entry into Govt. B.Ed. College, Soreng, West Sikkim.*

1. Candidates should have undergone 3 yrs B.A./B.Sc. Pass Course/Honors Course/Post Graduation Course from the UGC recognized Institutions.
2. Candidates should have taken School Teaching Subjects at the Graduation/Post Graduation Level.
3. Candidates with Vocational Course and IT are not allowed admission.
4. Candidates should have secured a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate for General Category, 47% for OBC and 45% for SC & ST Category. (This is as per the state norms).
5. If the stated percentage is not fulfilled, marks obtained in the Post Graduation level can also be considered for applying.
6. After filling on-line form, the candidate should download the filled-up form and submit the same with following documents in the administrative section of the Govt. B.Ed. College, Soreng, West Sikkim as per the date & time given.
  - a. Class X and XII Mark sheet and Certificate.
  - b. Graduation mark sheet and Certificate/Post graduation marks sheet and Certificate.
  - c. Migration certificate for applicant other than SU.
  - d. Birth Certificate.
  - e. Category Certificate.
  - f. COI Certificate (for within state applicant).
  - g. Two pass port size photograph.
  - h. Migration certificate for applicants other than SU.
7. Admission will be done on Merit.
8. Result will be declared after necessary approval from the higher authority of the Education Department.
9. Distribution of seats after reservation should be distributed by considering the pro-rata basis and the number of applications from each district i.e. – East, West, North and South.
10. Vacant Seats / if any selected candidates withdraw for taking admission, the vacant seat will be filled up by the candidate from the same district who are 'merit in waiting'.
11. In case Seats allotted to in-service candidates, differently abled candidates and candidates from outside state remain vacant, the same will be allotted to candidates who

are merit in waiting from each district. The distribution of these seats should be made taking care of pro-rata and number of applicants from each district with the prior approval from the Director of Higher Education.

12. Selected candidates should take admission within **four days** from the declaration of merit list. If the selected candidates do not inform the College, his/her seats will be automatically allotted in the candidates who are 'merit in waiting'.
13. If the candidate leaves the course after taking admission within 15 – 20 days, the college should be allowed to fill-up the vacant seat by candidates who are 'merit in waiting'.
14. If anyone wants the list of selected candidates, same can be given through the third party's consent and along with this, permission letter from the higher authority of the HRDD should be brought. In such case, only Roll No. and total marks of the selected candidates will be given.

**Total No of seats for B.Ed. 2020 session as per NCTE = 150**

All seats to be filled in on merit as mentioned in guidelines with the following broad category wise reservation:

- a. In-service GTs /PGTs/ School Heads Teachers = 20
- b. Differently able students (COI holder) = 03 seats
- c. Non Local Students/without COI = 10
- d. Open for COI holders only = 117
